## The Most Wonderful Time Of The Year

It's the time of year when many people start searching for ideas for holiday party treats, teacher gifts and cookie exchanges. Lucky for you, I found an extremely delicious and easy-to-make recipe for a delightful holiday treat!

#### **CHOCOLATE PEANUT BUTTER BALLS**

2 cups creamy peanut butter

2 packages (1lb each) chocolate candy coating or semi-sweet chocolate chips

3 3/4 cup powdered sugar

½ teaspoon vanilla extract

3/4 cup salted butter

Mix the peanut butter, salted butter and vanilla together in a large bowl.

Add in the powdered sugar a little at a time. You'll know when you've added enough because the mixture will hold

together very well in one giant ball in your mixing bowl.

Cover and let sit in the refrigerator for 15-25 minutes until the mixture firms up.

Shape the dough into 1-inch balls and then cover and refrigerate again for about 15-20 minutes. Skipping this step makes the dough very hard to dip into the chocolate.

Melt the chocolate according to the package directions. Dip the peanut butter balls one at a time into the melted chocolate.

Let the excess chocolate drip off and pool a little when you set it down.

Place the dipped ball onto wax paper and let it harden.

Chill until ready to serve. Enjoy!

It's the perfect venue for completing your holiday shopping while benefitting a great cause.

This year's show will feature unique, handmade creations from over 300 artists and top-quality craftspeople. The exceptional quality of the arts and crafts is ensured through a jury selection process in which hundreds of applications are submitted by artists and craftspeople from across the United States.

Many different kinds of works are offered, including fine arts, country furniture, photography, metalwork, ceramics, stained glass, woodwork, glasswork, dolls, clocks, calligraphy, home décor, stocking stuffers and much, much more.

For just about any age, shape or size, Sky Zone is the ultimate 3-D play experience!

On any given day, you can enter through the hidden driveway between the Fire Station and Thomasville Road Baptist Church and explore the gardens of this hidden oasis.

Looking for a unique location to host an event? The home is available to rent for parties, receptions, and even weddings!

Of all of the fantastic seasons in Tallahassee that you could visit the lovely park, November and December are when this place truly comes to life! Every year starting in November, you can drive through and see the hardworking grounds keepers rushing tirelessly to get

all of the holiday lights ready for a festivity like no other!

Massive twinkling snowflakes illuminate the sky, as the garden paths are lined with polar bears, sleighs, elves, and Christmas trees. When you think "Christmas Decorations" – this place has got it!




