On Saturday, April 23, 2016, Tallahassee will be hosting its second annual Slide The City event to kick off at Macomb St. and Madison St. near the Civic Center.

This world-record slide comes with 1000 feet of pure adrenaline as a family friendly water party event going right through the streets of our great city.

There will be live music, food, drinks, water, and of course the world's largest slip-n-slide to ever hit the asphalt. The slide is cushioned to protect its

participants, and all party-goers must use a flotation device.

Spectators are encouraged to bring water buckets, squirt guns, super soakers, or anything they can think of to keep the water flowing and splash the sliders on their way down.

Participants can choose between a Single Slider (one trip down), Triple Slider (3 trips down), or Ultimate Slider (unlimited trips down).

Starting at just \$20, you get an entry wristband, drawstring bag, and a mouth guard - yes it can get that crazy ... crazy FUN!

All participants must bring an inflatable tube to slide with or may purchase one at the event.

Discover Another Great Tallahassee Park

If you've ever driven down Meridian Road, you've probably noticed the Forrest Meadows Athletic Center with its 19 lighted tennis courts, tennis backboards, 3 indoor racquetball courts, 1 indoor squash court, 2 weight rooms, and luxurious locker rooms with a unisex spa.

What you may not have noticed is that this Athletic Center is adjacent to Elinor Klapp-Phipps Park, a beautiful 670 acre tract of land on the eastern shore of Lake Jackson.



The Elinor Klapp-Phipps Park (EKP Park, through the cooperative efforts of the Northwest Florida Water Management District, the City of Tallahassee, and the property owner, Colin Phipps, was purchased in October of 1992.

The City purchased 162 acres outright, containing two existing active recreation areas. The Meadows Soccer Complex on Millers Landing Road will continue to function as a youth and adult soccer facility, and the Meridian Park area has been re-developed as a multi-use youth sports complex.

The vast majority of the park, over 600 acres, is utilized for passive forms of recreation and environmental

education.

The property was once part of a much larger parcel known as Ayavalla Plantation. The Park is named in honor of Elinor Klapp-Phipps, nicknamed "Klippy," mother of Colin Phipps and wife of John H. Phipps.

The Park is managed for recreation and to preserve and restore watershed for Lake Jackson. There are 10 miles of shared-use trails that include mountain biking and equestrian use, 7 miles of dedicated hiking trails, and 4 miles of dedicated mountain bike trails.

Maclay Gardens State Park can accessed via a pedestrian crossing of N. Meridian Road, on the east side of the Park, next to Forestmeadows or by entering Maclay Gardens State Park's main entrance on Thomasville Road.

Together the state park and EKP Park properties create a unique greenway corridor stretching over 4 miles across north Tallahassee. The Park is also home to the Red Hills International Horse Trials.



Please take a day trip and visit this beautiful park. Now that the weather is starting to warm up, get outside and enjoy the fresh Tallahassee air!

And at 10:30 – the main event: The Springtime Tallahassee Parade! The theme for the parade this year is "Let the FUNshine In"!

The Grand Marshal of the parade this year is TCC President Dr. Jim Murdaugh. He was chosen for the honor based on the wonderful contributions he has made to TCC and the Tallahassee community at large!

In the early years of Springtime Tallahassee, the event leaders wanted to develop something for the festival that emphasized Tallahassee's varied historical background. They came up with the idea of creating five Krewes, one for each of the major time periods in the city's history: Spanish, American Territory, Antebellum Statehood, War & Reconstruction and 20th Century.



The Springtime Tallahassee Parade is one of the largest in the southeast, attracting over 70,000 attendees and providing colorful entertainment for everyone.


