



One of the reasons why I love Tallahassee so much is the abundance of great parks.

If you enjoy the outdoors, then don't miss my *Exploration Series*, which will feature a different Tallahassee park each month this year. This month I'm highlighting one of Tallahassee's hidden eastside parks, the Lafayette Heritage Trail Park.

Lafayette Heritage Trail Park, along with adjacent Tom Brown Park, is bounded on the north by the Lake Lafayette system, stretching from Weems Road to Chaires Cross Road. Originally this system was a wet prairie, filling during heavy rains then draining through sinkholes into the Floridian Aquifer.

Over millennia, when the lakes drained, Native Americans hunted and gathered flint for tools and weapons on the lake bottom. In historic times farmers grazed cattle and planted crops in the fertile lake soil.

Two dams constructed around 1950 divided the lake into three sections: Upper Lafayette, Piney Z, and Lower Lafayette. Upper Lafayette continues to be a wet prairie, Piney Z Lake is a 200 acre open water lake, and Lower Lafayette resembles a cypress-covered Louisiana bayou.

The park offers visitors a place to fish, exercise, bike, run, walk or just sit and reflect. There are many scenic views and opportunities to view the wildlife.

The park entrance is found at the east end of Heritage Park Blvd., in the Piney Z

Plantation subdivision. There you will find a small parking lot with 3 picnic shelters, a trailhead and bike wash, a small playground, and restroom.

Drinking water is provided at the trailhead and at the playground. This hidden gem provides fun for the entire family.

The largest parcel, formerly part of the Piney Z Plantation, was acquired from Grace Dansby in December 1995. A second parcel was purchased from Byron Block in June of 1996 for a total of 795.14 acres!



Funding for the acquisition of this Park was provided by the City of Tallahassee and the Florida Communities Trust using Florida Forever Funds. The total cost of acquisition was \$3,562,566.90.

Piney Z Lake is cooperatively managed by the City of Tallahassee and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.

Additionally, if you are interested in finding and exploring the park trails, you can [download an app](#) that allows you to search for a trails, scan QR codes on trails to find your location, and browse amenity lists.

Living In A Birders Paradise

If you're a "birder", then you probably already know some of what I'm sharing in this article. But if not, then you're missing a great opportunity to appreciate wildlife at its best in our area.

For those unfamiliar with the term "birder", it applies to a large group of slightly crazy people who love to spend hours upon hours with a pair of binoculars trooping through the brush, sitting on their back porch or taking walks through our many state parks and wildlife areas in pursuit of lovely flying things.



Many birders take their bird watching so seriously that they keep a "life list" of the species they see and will travel to distant places to see birds they don't have on their life list yet.

Tallahassee is fortunate in several ways for those who seek to view birds or wildlife, as well as finding opportunities to volunteer on a variety of local wildlife projects.

Our climate, location along the gulf coast and varied wildlife habits are

inviting to a variety of birds that fly through this area in the winter. Probably the most notable is the Whooping Crane.

The tallest of all the birds in North America it is named for the sound it makes, and it is on the Endangered Species List. A team of people have actually created a project that uses an ultralight flown from the northern US down to St. Marks Wildlife Refuge each Winter, and guides them back in the spring.

It has been amazingly successful and you can read more about them in this [article in the Tallahassee Democrat](#).

An amazing resource for all things bird is our local chapter of the Audubon Society. The [Appalachee Audubon Society](#) brings in speakers during the winter months and their meetings are open to the public.

They also publish a newsletter that lists current events, articles on various issues, and ways people can volunteer. This month's issue has several in-depth [articles on the Whoopers](#), well worth a read if you are interested in these fabulous birds.

And perhaps the best way to support AAS and the local efforts to improve wildlife habitats, protect birds and animals, and enjoy some quality time outdoors is to become a member.

AAS provides many great benefits, including guided tours of places like Tall Timbers Research Station, the St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge, and other great habitat areas in the Greater Tallahassee.


