If you live in Florida, chances are that you're only a short drive from the nearest pool or body of water. As fun and exciting as that is, it also necessitates education on water safety and makes learning to swim a priority.

As parents, we want to know that our children are always safe, so finding a quality "Learn-to-Swim" program rises quickly on our priority list.

According to the Florida Department of Health, the state of Florida loses more children under age five to drowning than any other state. In 2013, Florida had the highest unintentional drowning rate in the nation for children ages 1–4 with a drowning rate of 7.54 per 100,000.

Furthermore, Florida had the second highest drowning rate in the nation for children ages 1–14 with a drowning rate of 2.54 per 100,000. Only Oklahoma had more drownings among that age group.

As a former American Red Cross certified life guard and swim instructor, I am very critical of Learn-to-Swim programs and I know that high quality

swimming instructors are more of a rare find these days.

Learning to swim is not an easy task and it involves a number of skills working together to achieve a goal. Combine that with overcoming the initial fear of the water that most kids have and you create quite an obstacle for swimming instructors to overcome.

A good swimming instructor understands his student. They understand how they learn at different ages, how to keep their attention, how to motivate them, the importance of good logical teaching progression and proper instruction techniques.

Over the years I have scouted out various Learn-to-Swim programs around Tallahassee and I have included links to a list of programs in the side bar that, in my opinion, provide quality swim lessons.

Most of the early summer sessions fill up quickly and you don't want to have to wait for late July or early August to start your lessons. So please don't delay signing up!



Asy, so I'm breaking a rule today. This is not supposed to be a real estate newsletter, but Tallahassee has an annual event that has been going on for 61 consecutive years, and it sure seems worthy of sharing with our readers.



The event is the Tallahassee Parade of Homes sponsored each year by the Tallahassee Builders Association (TBA).

Whether you are currently a home owner, perhaps in the throes of building your own new home or dreaming about your "someday" home, this event provides the opportunity to see the newest in home design and products in real time.

Some of Tallahassee's best home builders participate each year, building a house targeted to be completed in time for the show. This is their chance to show off what they are capable of, the products or designs they specialize in and attract new customers that may be thinking of building new homes.

Spread over two weekends in May (7-8th and 14-15th) the event is very popular and provides a glance into the inner workings of really nice, newly completed homes.

Each entry is judged against the competition by a group of real estate agents, non-competing builders and designers for various awards, like "Best In Show".

In recent years the TBA also added the ability for the public to go online and submit votes for their favorites.

There are 20 entries in this year's show, priced from \$114,900 for a three bedroom three bath condominium in University Green Student Condominiums to an 8300 sf house off Thomasville Rd with four bedrooms, 4.5 baths and a nice 3-car garage.

The TBA prints a wonderful magazine for the Parade, complete with a map of the sites, a page on each of the construction entries, and articles relevant to today's homeowners.

This year's magazine features articles about hiring a good remodeler, building with "green" technology, and new home design trends. I've actually included your very own copy for download in the sidebar.

Even if you don't have any plans to buy a new home, I can promise that you'll enjoy every bit of the Parade of Homes this year. I've been a part of it for years, and it never disappoints!
