That's right! There's a bus that will take you to 7 different locations on the "Craft Crawl Route" where you'll be able to taste some of the finest brews known to man.



As we enter into the height of our sunny summer season in Florida, everyone is looking for ways to keep cool while still enjoying the outdoors. As the temperatures begin to rise, it might be great weather for us, but not always for our pets.

Here are some easy tips to keep your pets safe and cool during the summer season.

1. Do not leave your pets anywhere you would not want to be! Enclosed spaces are extremely dangerous during these hotter months. Parked cars and plastic kennels becoming increasingly dangerous in direct sunlight.

2. Be aware of the signs of heatstroke from overheating. Overheating is caused

from a severe increase in an animal's body temperature in excess of 104 degrees.

The ASPCA describes the symptoms of overheating as excessive panting or difficulty breathing, an increase in heart rate, seizures, and weakness, or even collapse.

3. Be careful when taking your pets for a walk on asphalt during the hottest parts of the day – if the concrete is too hot for a person to walk barefoot, it can easily burn the paws of your pet.

4. Always make sure your pets are hydrated. Pets can get dehydrated very quickly, so make sure to give your pets plenty of water as its gets warmer outside.

There are over 50 state parks in Florida that offer camping for tents, campers and RVs. Some of our state's most beautiful natural treasures can be found in these parks.

Dr. Julian G. Bruce St. George Island State Park is located on the very east end of St. George Island. Miles of undeveloped beaches provide some of the most spectacular views and scenery in the state.

Flounder, redfish, sea trout, pompano, Spanish mackerel and whiting can be caught off the beach or in the bay. If you plan to stay for the night the campground offers 60 campsites with water, electric, and two bathhouses.

If you'd rather go the primitive route, two more primitive campsites can be accessed by a 2.5 mile trail. Florida Caverns State Park located just down the road in Marianna is one of the most unique natural treasures in the country, not just the Sunshine State. This amazing park offers majestic springs, rivers, campgrounds, and much more for all ages to enjoy.



Some of the highest elevations in the state make <u>Torreya State Park</u> one of Florida's most unique and scenic places. The park is named for an extremely rare species of tree that only grows along the bluffs of the Apalachicola River.

This park is popular for camping, hiking and bird-watching. Over 100 species of birds have been spotted in the park over the years. The park's high plateaus, steep bluffs and deep ravines provide a challenging hiking terrain.




